Dear Parents and Staff,

Next week will be a fun one for all of our staff and students because it's Catholic Schools Week, CSW, and we encourage parents to join us with some of the activities:

- 1. come join any of the weekend Parish Masses and hear SJRS and OLMA parents talk about the value of a Catholic Christian education;
- 2. attend our weekly Wednesday Mass at 9:30 am (families who come sit together with their children) and hear our OLMA Student Council President Francis Cardine talk about his time at both schools. (For more on this outstanding student, **check out the Keene Sentinel article here**.)
- 3. watch the SJRS Spelling Bee at 9 am in the gym. Grades 4-8 compete. All parents welcome.
- 4. sign up for the OLMA Granite Gorge trip of January 31 and enjoy skiing or tubing (see communication from OLMA) or the SJRS Alpine Club on the same day.

Note 1: we are showing 'appreciation' to all our hardworking staff by having an early release day on the 31st. The SJRS dismissal is at 11:45 and no Extended Day! The OLMA dismissal is at 11:30.

Note 2: We have 4 dress downs during CSW. Wednesday is the exception when SJRS students are in uniform for Mass, and OLMA students dress up for Mass. All monies collected will be sent to Corpus Christi Catholic School which was destroyed by the recent LA fires.

Note 3: A small but energetic group of parents attended the Home and School meeting last night. Next meeting is February 19 at 6 pm in the Parish hall. It's clear that parents want to become more involved and start planning some additional fundraisers to help our schools with expenses and past debt. Next week's newsletter will include the minutes from this meeting and the start of a few subcommittees to get things rolling. All parents are asked to send me ideas for fundraisers, and actually, any topics that need more details or clarification.


