

UPCOMING COLLEGE VISITS

Wednesday, October 2

The University of Dallas is a private Catholic university located in Irving, Texas (and the alma mater of our principal, Miss Farrington!) . Established in 1956, it is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools with an undergraduate enrollment of 1,500 students and graduate enrollment of 1,038 students. The university comprises three academic units: the Braniff Graduate School of Liberal Arts, the Constantin College of Liberal Arts, and the Satish & Yasmin Gupta College of Business. Dallas offers several master's degree programs and a doctoral degree program with three concentrations.

Friday, October 11

Xavier University is a private Jesuit university in Cincinnati, Ohio. It is the sixth-oldest Catholic and fourth-oldest Jesuit university in the United States. Xavier has an undergraduate enrollment of 4,860 students and graduate enrollment of 1,269 students. Xavier offers more than 90 majors and 60 minors within the College of Arts and Sciences, the College of Professional Sciences, the Williams College of Business and the College of Nursing. Xavier also offers programs for students who plan to further their education in medicine, dentistry, veterinary medicine, optometry, and pharmacy.

Friday, October 18

Saint Anselm College is a private Benedictine liberal arts college in Goffstown, New Hampshire. Founded in 1888, it is the third oldest Catholic College in New England. It is ranked as a Top 100 Liberal Arts Colleges by Forbes and Princeton Review ranks it #24 most engaged in community service.
